

Manager, Utility Wildfire Mitigation

Summary/Objective

- Consulting
 - Serve as a subject matter expert on wildfire mitigation strategies, programs, and prevalent practices within the electric utility industry.
 - Advise and support internal and external stakeholders on prevention strategies. regulatory requirements, technological solutions, and risk management practices.
 - o Engage with client regulators, government agencies, community groups, and other key stakeholders to communicate wildfire mitigation strategies, respond to inquiries, and gather input to identify, refine and improve mitigation efforts.
 - Collaborate with client legal, compliance, and policy teams to develop and refine wildfire mitigation policies and procedures.
 - o Ensure alignment with local, state, and federal regulations and prevalent industry practices.
 - o Assess utility wildfire mitigation programs and plans, identify opportunities for improvement, and make recommendations to enhance and improve wildfire mitigation performance.
 - Lead or support the assessment and prioritization of wildfire risks associated with utility infrastructure. Recommend and implement measures to mitigate these risks, including vegetation management, equipment upgrades, and operational changes.
 - Collaborate with stakeholders to monitor performance and continuously improve client wildfire mitigation program initiatives and related tactical execution and operationalization efforts.
 - Identify, develop, and follow-up on business opportunities to expand and grow wildfire mitigation consulting and services.

- Develop comprehensive project plans for wildfire mitigation initiatives, including scope, timeline, budget, and resource allocation. Ensure that projects are aligned with the client's strategic objectives.
- Oversee the execution of consulting services, deliverables, and wildfire mitigation projects, ensuring they are completed on time, within budget, and to the highest quality standards. This includes managing internal teams, contractors, and vendors.
