- Observe concrete and soil field tests.
- Maintain all contract documents, necessary permits, and updated drawings.
- Ensure a safety conscious work environment and initiate corrective action, as necessary.

Work Environment / Physical Demands:

- Daily inspections require traveling to and maneuvering through various construction sites in all weather conditions.
- This job is in an outdoor field environment; vehicle and foot patrol of utility power lines; remote locations
 as well as urban, city environment; physical demands and travel from site to site, including walking/hiking
 on various surfaces including flat, dry, wet, slippery, uneven, rough, steep terrain, hills and slopes;
 exposure to noise, dust, grease, and all types of weather and temperature conditions; exposure to
 hazardous traffic conditions.
- Physical requirements include walking, sitting for long periods of time, manual dexterity, hearing, seeing, lifting, and driving a motor vehicle. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 25 pounds. The noise level in the work environment is low to moderate but can be noisy at times during the construction process.
- The employee must have sufficient physical ability and mobility to work in a field environment; to walk, stand, sit, and operate a motor vehicle for prolonged periods of time; to frequently stoop, bend, kneel, crouch, climb, reach, twist, grasp and make repetitive hand movement in the performance of daily duties; carry, push and/or pull light to moderate amounts of weight (up to 25 pounds); to operate assigned equipment and vehicles; ability to see and hear in normal range with or without correction; operate assigned field equipment.
- Climbing ladders is possible.
