

Transmission Line/ Substation Civil Inspector

Summary/Objective

The Transmission Line/Substation Civil Inspector role is primarily responsible for overseeing construction of contracted projects. The inspector will perform daily on-site inspections to verify the work is being completed in strict accordance with drawings and specifications of approved project documents.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Properly observe testing requirements for drilled pier foundations, access roads and yard rock, direct embedded pole excavation, disk anchor installation, and other possible foundations
- Interact professionally with Contractors by providing clear, accurate, and timely communications
- Create and maintain daily detailed inspection reports
- Review any discrepancies with appropriate parties
- Maintain all contract documents, necessary permits, and updated drawings
- Ensure a safety conscious work environment, and initiate corrective action as necessary

Qualifications/Experience:

- 5 years minimum working knowledge of Transmission and Substation facilities and foundations
- Previous substation construction: and transmission line construction/inspection experience preferred
- Good driving record
- Ability to read plans and specifications
- Knowledge of construction principles and techniques
- Proficient with Microsoft Office and able to perform basic web-based tasks
- Possess and maintain necessary certificates including but are not limited to:
 - FHWA – NHI – 132070 (Drilled Shaft Inspector's Qualification)
 - ACI Concrete Field-Testing Grade I Certification or Higher

Work Environment / Physical Demands:

- Able to lift a minimum of 30 lbs. or more at any given time throughout the day
- Must be able to walk on average 3+ miles per day across rough terrain and/or unlevel surfaces
- Ability to step in and out of a full-size 4x4 pickup truck several times a day
- Able to work/drive in potentially harsh weather conditions
- Must be willing and able to wear the following company-supplied PPE:
 - Hard hat
 - Safety glasses with side shields
 - Safety-toed shoes
 - Flame-resistant (FR) class 2 protection upper-body wear
 - Garments worn under FR clothing should be silk, cotton or wool. Synthetic clothing should not be worn. Arc Thermal Protective Value (ATPV) rating must be greater than 8.

Position Type/Expected Hours of Work:

- This is a full-time non-exempt/hourly plus discretionary bonus position
- The work hours will flex during peak demands of construction
- Willing to work up to 12 hours per day; 5/6 days a week.
